- Young People's Unit inpatient services
- Community hostels and specialised facilities offering sheltered accommodation
- Liaison psychiatric service at Mater Dei Hospital
- Inpatient Services at Mount Carmel Hospital

Mental Health Services aims to promote mental health within the Maltese society by:

- Assisting persons with mental health problems who require specialist treatment and care as well as support for their social network.
- Providing through specialist multi-disciplinary teams, a comprehensive and integrated range of community and hospital mental health services.
