The Programme Implementation Directorate consists of a Director, Assistant Director, an EU Fund Manager, Senior Policy officer and a Principal.

The directorate's functions and responsibilities include the following:

- Monitoring the implementation of EU funded projects being implemented by the different departments and entities falling under the responsibility of MFH; including projects funded by the ESF; ERDF; Italia-Malta; CEF; AMIF, ERASMUS, ECC Fellowship Programme, Research and Innovation, Horizon 2020 and the EU's Health Programme;
- Providing guidance and support as necessary regarding EU funding so that MFH ensures maximum funds uptake opportunities as much as possible; Contact point for the Single Digital Gateway Regulation. DPI is responsible for the coordination and implementation of the SDG regulation by the entities of the Ministry for Health.
- Providing the required support and assistance to Project Leaders in the Implementation of EU funded programmes.
- Assist MFH entities to absorb EU funding for their respective projects.
- Coordinate with MFH entities on issues related to State Aid General Description of the Categories of Documents Held
- EU funded project files including tenders published, and payments processed
- Files related to EU funded programmes Monitoring Committees
- Annual Reports of DPI
- DPI Operations and Personnel Files
