Environmental Health Directorate

Structure, Functions and Responsibilities

The Directorate has a centralised structure with a Head Office at Santa Venera, a Public Health Laboratory at Valletta, Port Health Offices at Floriana and MIA Gudja, and a Regional Office in Gozo. The Directorate is also responsible for the administration of Government cemeteries with an administration office at the Addolorata Cemetery in Paola. The Pest Control Unit operates from two offices situated in San Gwann and Luqa. The Health Certificate and Consultation Unit offers its services from Santa Venera.

The Mission Statement of the Environmental Health Directorate is:

The Environmental Health Directorate promotes and safeguards the health and wellbeing of the public from possible environmental effects.

Strategies in order to address the Directorate's responsibilities:

- Ensure the effective and consistent enforcement of food and environmental health legislation;

- Ensure that the Directorate is responsive, efficient and effective and delivers value for money.
